What SAP-C02 tests</h3> <p>Enterprise AWS architecture — not single-service trivia.</p> <p>Cross-account design — governance, identity, logging, and shared services.</p> <p>Network decisions — TGW, DX, PrivateLink, Route 53, CloudFront.</p> <p>Migration choices — rehost vs replatform vs refactor.</p> <p>Optimization loops — cost, performance, security, and operations.</p>	<h3>2. High-yield governance facts</h3> <p>SCP = max allowed at account/OU level.</p> <p>IAM Identity Center = workforce SSO across accounts.</p> <p>Control Tower = landing zone + guardrails.</p> <p>Config = resource compliance state.</p> <p>CloudTrail = API audit history.</p>
<h3>3. High-yield architecture picks</h3> <p>TGW for many VPCs/accounts.</p> <p>PrivateLink for private service exposure.</p> <p>DX for stable hybrid bandwidth.</p> <p>Global Accelerator for global TCP/UDP entry.</p> <p>CloudFront for edge caching and app acceleration.</p>	<h3>4. High-yield optimization picks</h3> <p>Savings Plans for flexible steady usage.</p> <p>Spot for interrupt-tolerant capacity.</p> <p>Auto Scaling for variable demand.</p> <p>DMS for migrations; SCT for schema conversion.</p> <p>Well-Architected reviews for structured improvement.</p>
